## LOS ANGELES HAS GONE TO HELL.

The entire city was sent to hell as punishment for ANGEL taking a stand against Wolfram & Hart. The town has been divided by Demon Lords, the human civilians enslaved.

But Wolfram & Hart wasn't done there. They made Angel human for that added dose of helplessness and forced a recently deceased WESLEY to stand by Angel's side, as an incorporeal ghost. Rounding out the trio is a giant DRAGON sent to kill Angel that instead became his pet, chief mode of transportation, and confidant. Wesley and the Dragon are the only other living beings aware that Angel is no longer a vampire, his secret kept by potions and glammers.

The remaining members of Angel's former crew have gone their separate ways, each one not knowing what has become of the other. For instance, everyone thinks CHARLES GUNN has died. This is not the case. Gunn, who was mortally wounded in the moments before the city's descent into hell, has been turned into a vampire. Still thinking himself a hero, Gunn has since done the following:

- 1) Honed his abilities by training with what appears to be kidnapped slayer prisoners.
- 2) Killed the Lord of Westwood, the Lord's followers, and stolen a magical item that boosted the Lord's powers.
- 3) Kidnapped the telekinetic fish BETTA GEORGE.
- 4) Framed SPIKE and ILLYRIA for deaths of humans Gunn himself killed.

Which leads Angel to head to Beverly Hills, where Spike and Illyria have taken over as Lords. From outward appearances, it seems as though Spike and Illyria have returned to their old ways—Spike spending his days hanging out with a supernatural harem, and Illyria spending her days hitting things.

Angel confronts them, but discovers that not only is Spike NOT murdering anyone, he's secretly saving humans with CONNOR. Connor is running a safe haven for the citizens of Los Angeles, working alongside NINA (the werelady ex-girlfriend of Angel) and GWEN (electric powers out of control in hell, making her unable, once again, to touch a human being without killing them).

Angel, perhaps somewhat jealous of Spike and Connor's new relationship, challenges the Lords to combat. If Angel wins, they surrender control of the city. If Angel loses, Angel dies.

Angel and Wesley are summoned by LORNE. Lorne has found his calling in Silverlake, where he rose up and became Lord, creating the only pleasant area of hell. He has enlisted the GROOSALUGG to act as the city's protector. Lorne and Groo arm Angel to the (formerly fanged) teeth...

... which he'll need, as the Lords have assembled a motley crew of champions to fight in their name. And if that's not enough, they each have a mystical device that when triggered will turn Angel's insides out. Spike and Illyria, as Lords, are given one of the devices. Spike's harem wants Spike to use it on Angel and rise up to take over the city.

The day of the battle, after a heartfelt speech where Angel apologizes to all of Los Angeles for sending them to hell, the battle begins...

...and Angel is quickly overpowered. Thankfully, Lorne has assembled the troops, and reunited the band. Angel, Spike, Illyria, Connor, Gwen, Nina, and The Dragon fight side by side. Gunn watches from the rooftops, declaring that he orchestrated the entire thing.

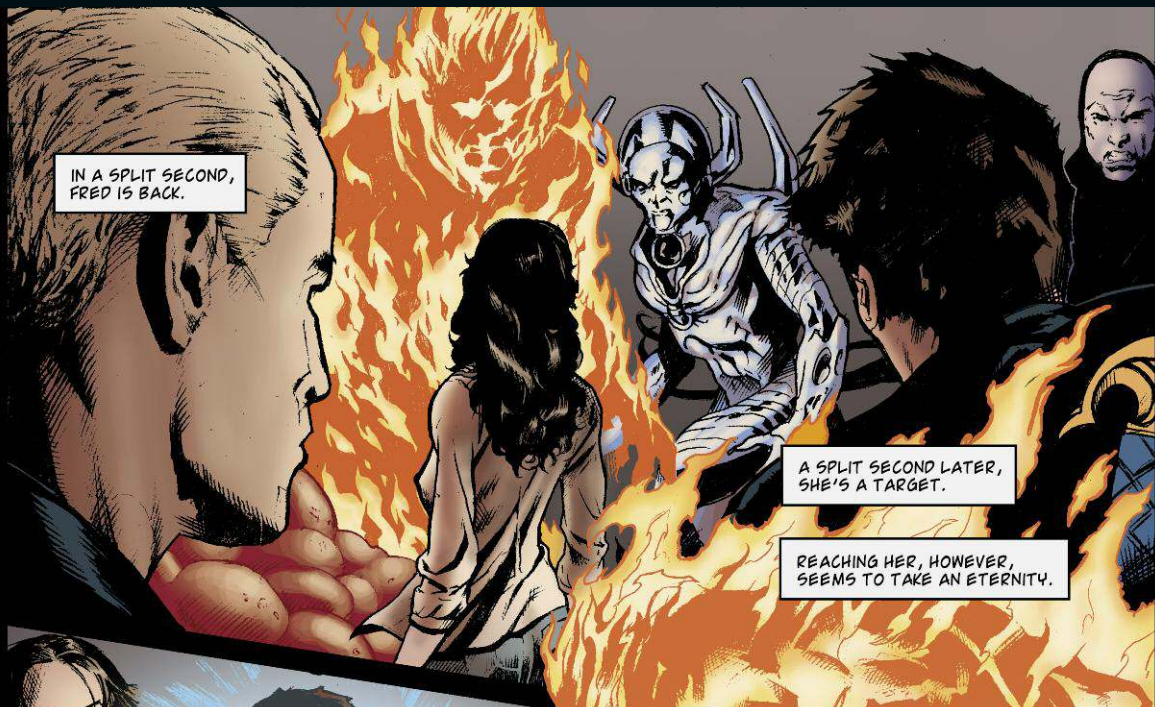

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## THROUGH THE FISHBOWL · The On-Set Diary of Betta George

NOTE: The Following was excerpted from the diary of Betta George, telepathic fish and co-star of Angel: After the Fall. This was taken specifically from the days George filmed his scenes for issue 10. The opinions of George are not necessarily those of IDW.

### ISSUE 10, PAGE 7

So far, this shoot has been a weird one. My character started as a slave and is now a prisoner. The other actors get to ride on the backs of dragons and fight dinosaurs; I get tied to a bed. But hey, it's a job. And it's high profile, right? I mean, it must be, I'm getting a ton of emails about it already. Most of them start with "You're not canon" and end with "seriously, a fish?"



Gunn, my co-star for the bulk of my scenes, is an interesting guy. He's polite, doesn't step on my lines (it's happened before, Looking at you, William the Bloody!) But, well...

...take the other day, when Gunn drained a production assistant dry, right in front of the crew. Sucked her blood, and then pointed at me and said "the fish did it." AND THEY SIDED WITH GUNN. I complained to Whedon, who shrugged and explained Gunn was actually on the show so he's more important. I was shocked, what show was Whedon talking about? I gotta consult Wikipedia Later.

Anyway, at least I'm not tied to a bed today. Good, enough of that stupid bed, Let's move onto something more cinematic... Like, oh, say, a basement. Fantastic. Prisoner in a basement. Someone's been watching *Silence of the Lambs*. At least Gunn isn't making me put the Lotion in the basket.

We filmed my close-up last. Gunn, of course, being the star of Whedon's imaginary series, gets to shoot his footage first.

For my coverage, Gunn's back in his trailer taking a nap. That's not even HIS Leg kneecing me in the fish-stomach. But rest assured, that is most definitely MY stomach. I have the bruises to prove it. We tried a stunt double for the first couple of issues but the footage didn't match. That's what you get for dressing a short Mexican dude in a fish costume and trying to pass him off as me. Truth be told, though, I miss Pablo. He had a lot of great stories. Oh, and he never blamed me when production assistants popped up dead on set.



### ISSUE 10, PAGE 8

Got a lot of great close-ups here, nice splash shot. The dialog, however, yikes. "Stop! Stop! Stop!" I fear that this is EXACTLY the kind of lazy writing that will prevent me from even be nominated for a Best Supporting Actor Eisner. I just know Jimmy Olsen's gonna take it. It's his year. OR maybe that Luke Cage dude. Bendis gives that guy, like, pages of monologues. I get "stop!" "stop!"

The slayer ladies were nice. But I will say this: the fact that they were trapped in a five-minute time loop made it really difficult for them to learn lines, which led to cue cards, which prevented them from being 100% in the scene with me. I heard one of them just booked a couple of panels in the next Scott Pilgrim. Good for her!

### ISSUE 10, PAGE 15

This was a huge character moment for me. Gunn, while completely insane and evil, is actually able to help me channel my power in ways never thought possible. A few of the crew actually CRIED when we shot this. Oh sure, it might have been because Gunn had just killed that Production Assistant, OR, more realistically, it might have been because I pulled off such a powerful scene so very well.

Can I actually push people to do what I want? Oh man, if that were true, there would be plenty of emailers and web boarders that would suddenly stop typing about how I'm not really "canon" and how it's a "disgrace" to the memory of some "TV show" by having me in the book. But no, I can't push people. Heh, that would be cool.

Oh, I should point out that the Slayer Lady actually punched me on this page. She said it was on accident, and then muttered "but maybe it will help your acting and reacting seem more real" and then I said "what did you just say?" and a time-slip occurred and she had no idea what I was talking about. And then Gunn tried to bite Ryall. It was awkward.

Ryall blamed me, by the way.





### ISSUE 10, PAGES 16-17

Oh man was this weird. The script said "Gunn wedgies slayer." Gunn "improvised" and stabbed her. What the hell was that about? I went right up to Lynch (egotistical jerk, but very very handsome) and asked him what was stopping Gunn from stabbing ME out of nowhere. Lynch looked me up and down and said, "have you checked out my frat zombie book 'yet?'" I think maybe he was drunk. God, I hope he was, sober people shouldn't act like that.



### ISSUE 10, PAGE 18

This should have been a real treat, working with Beck, one of my co-stars from *Spike: Asylum* and *Spike: Shadow Puppets*. I didn't have to be on-set for Beck's scenes, but I thought it would be cool to stop by the set and read my lines to her, you know, help her out.

BIG mistake, let me tell you. Beck was all "why did YOU get to go canon? I was the break-out star of *Asylum* and *Shadow Puppets*, available now on amazon.com." To make matters worse, TMZ was on set and caught the whole thing. So embarrassing.

### ISSUE 10, PAGES 20-21

I appreciate the fact that the writers FINALLY saw fit to let me get OUT of that awful hotel set, believe-you-me. But they made it snow, which is hell on the gills. I asked if I could have a production assistant hold an umbrella over me when we weren't filming, but Whedon said something about how it wasn't in the budget.

How was ONE umbrella not in the budget but all that make-up to hide the Dragon's plastic surgery scars IS? Oh sure, a fish can suffer in the snow, but God forbid a comic reader notices liposuction scars on a giant mythological beast.





It's treatment like this that is for serious making me feel better about sneaking my resumé out to other comic companies. I think I'd be a great fit over at Green Lantern Corps. I could be Limpet, the Green Lantern from Sector Awesome. Gotta remember to call my agent, ask if he's heard anything.

### ISSUE 10, PAGE 22

Finally I get some face-time with the title character. He didn't say much to me. He was busy buddying up to Gunn between takes, asking Gunn if he could get him anything to eat, asking Gunn if he was comfortable, begging for Gunn's forgiveness. There was an awkward air between them. They have history that I can't even begin to fathom. I asked Whedon what was up with that, and he looked at me and was all "have you seriously not seen the show?" and I had to think quickly and say "oh sure, it was great." I don't know if Whedon believed me. But seriously, what show is he talking about? Is he messing with me?

After this issue wrapped, we all went out to a pub and celebrated. Kind of a little "Issue 10 wrap party." It was a blast, the slayer girls are really nice when they're not leaning into punches, and Gunn loosened up a little. That is, until he drained a busboy. It got awkwardly quiet in the place until Angel ran up to ANOTHER busboy and bit him for a second, before laughing and saying "just kidding, I don't do that anymore" which everyone thought was a riot except for Gunn. That really rubbed him the wrong way. Whatever, Gunn, lighten up. Angel's hilarious, he should have his own show.

**Brian Lynch asked the good people of the IDW *Angel* forums to pose any questions they had about *Angel: After the Fall* issues 9–12. Now, he will answer them with the strength of roughly two men. Let’s go!**

### QUESTION 1

*These issues are packed with the climaxes you’ve been working toward since issue 1. From the talk between Wesley and Illyria at the end of #9, to everyone finding out about Angel’s humanity, to the Angel/Gunn showdown, the bombs planted in earlier issues are going off one after the other. Which of the big moments was most exciting to write, and why?*

Now would be a great time to point out that Pat Shand has reviewed every issue of *Angel: ATF* (and *Spike: ATF*, and any Whedon-related book) over at <http://buffyversecomics.blogspot.com>. The reviews usually go up the day the comics come out, and reading his thoughtful and in-depth reviews has become a bit of a ritual. To thank him for making working on the book all the more fun, I named one of Gunn’s gang after him. I wish there was more I can do. I tried to change Spike’s name to “Pat Shand” but Ryall was all “are you drunk?” to which I could only reply “maybe... and VERY.”

Pat is right about the bombs going off one after the other. Set-up over, now we plunge into the meat of the story, the moments we’ve been waiting to show. Wesley and Illyria’s reunion was great fun to write, as was tackling Angel and Gunn’s reunion, especially as it went sour. But of all the issues in this volume, I’d have to say the greatest joy came from penning Cordelia’s dialog. For one thing, I didn’t know I was going to get a chance. She wasn’t in the original series outline. In fact, Joss said her story was over, her death was final, and if she was going to come back it would have to be for a great reason.

As we got closer to writing Angel’s near-death issues, I knew it was going to be very odd to have Angel simply watching the action from a disembodied state without anyone to talk to. That’s when the idea to use Cordy came to me. And once I decided I was definitely going to use her, all these other reasons for her return started clicking. OF COURSE the Powers-That-Be would send her, they want Angel to go calmly and peacefully. And of course she wouldn’t care what her mission was, she was going to help Angel any way she could.

Cordelia was always one of my favorite characters on *Buffy* and *Angel* so writing her pages was a real honor. I was in a good mood any day Cordelia and Angel had dialog. It was an honor to give her life again. I hope I did the character justice.

### QUESTION 2

*1. Is there any character that you feel "translates" less well than others to the comic medium? And which character do you feel "translates" the best to the medium?*

*2. When it comes to bringing dead characters back, what's the bigger consideration: the positive effects this might have on your current storyline, or the negative effects this might have on a previous storyline/scene (e.g., Fred's death in "A Hole in the World," or Wesley's death in "Not Fade Away")?*

3. *Was there anything in Angel: After the Fall or Spike: After the Fall that the fans just weren't getting, to your surprise/frustration?*

4. *Will any more old characters be showing up after Issue 12?*

5. *If you could choose just one scene (from the ones we—the readers—have seen so far) to be acted out by the televised series' actors, which would it be?*

6. *"Shipping": mostly flattering or mostly intimidating, from your new perspective as a VIP?*

7. *Is there any idea (yours or Joss') that you kind of regret scrapping? (If so, can you tell us what it was?)*

—Enisy

Great questions. It's weird to see "Question 2" when it is, in fact, questions 2–8, but let's ignore that and answer!

1. I think all the characters work wonderfully in the comic medium. The only problem is you miss all the subtle nuances the actors bring to the dialog, so sometimes it's difficult to gauge tone just from reading it. That said, Angel is helped greatly in comic form, as he's not the most verbose guy in the room but through narration we can really get into his head.

2. Bringing characters back from the dead is tricky. Wesley, for instance, had a very powerful and moving death on the show. I don't want to ruin it by bringing him back and giving him nothing to do. I didn't know if "Ghost Wesley" would work, but it was Joss' idea, and I don't know if you've noticed, most ideas that come from his head are quite wonderful, so I went for it.

I tackled it like this: Wesley is back but he doesn't want to be. He's earned his happy ending, he wants to ride off into the sunset but Wolfram & Hart won't let him. So now he's going to do what he's best at: helping Angel fight the good fight. This was underlined bold-faced at the end of issue 9 when Wesley decides to give up looking for a way out.

Even "neutered" (he can't fight, he can't even turn pages in a book to do research) he's going to be a vital part of the team. Especially towards the end, just you wait. *After the Fall* would be a lesser book without that character, for sure.

3. Not that I thought she'd be the most beloved character in all of Whedon-dom, but a faction of very verbal, very passionate readers hate Spider. I think she's simply misunderstood. Also, I should point out I've gotten emails from people that DO love her. And to them, I want to say "thank you" and "I'm sorry, I don't have Spider's phone number, as she is fictional."

4. Popeye joins team Angel in issue 35.

5. One scene I'd like to have the actors perform. Wow. Angel and Wesley's

conversation in issue 1. Angel's speech in front of the masses in issue 5. The Wesley/Illyria conversation from issue 9. The aforementioned Cordy scenes. Any of Gunn's scenes, really. There is a scene in issue 16 I'd really like to see Mr. Boreanaz tackle.

6. I stay out of "shipping" conversations. Everyone's got an opinion as to who their favorite character should wind up with, and it's a testament to the actors and creators of *Angel* and *Buffy* that people get that passionate about it. Let's move on!

7. Not really, I'm pleased with how the story came out. At one point, one of the champions fighting Angel in issues 5 and 9 was going to be Pavayne from the "Hell Bound" episode of *Angel* (he was last seen held prisoner in Wolfram & Hart's basement). He was going to be dragging Angel on a "greatest hits" of his failures, and because of Pavayne's amped up hell powers, said failures were going to kick Angel's ass. Eventually he was going to be taken in by Gunn and then used to trap each character in their own "greatest hits" (or, you know, their own personal hell). That might have been fun, but it was cut for numerous reasons (time and story being just two).

### QUESTION 3

*Angel: After the Fall is often considered a blessing for the fans of Angel that have always wondered what happened to Angel and Co. after the infamous alley fight at the end of "Not Fade Away." As a writer and fellow fan of the series, what has been the greatest highlight of writing Angel: After the Fall so far? Any fan reactions that have surprised you, either positive or negative?*

—James Sexton

The greatest highlight? Meeting with Joss to talk to him about the series was a highlight of my life, let alone a highlight of working on the series. But seeing pages for the first time, and enjoying how the artists have elevated my script, that's a thrill that I will never, ever get used to.

The weirdest fan reactions? That is easy. Head over to YouTube and type "geeking out" into search. This will take you to a whole crapload of comic reviews from inside a Canadian comic store. Some lady named Leila and some dude who looks like the son from *Family Guy* review comics, and if a new *Angel* is out, they will talk about how they do not enjoy *Angel*. In a way they are the Bizarro Pat Shand, although I must say I get a kick out of watching their reviews. They are frustrated that we don't see the alley fight, they think it's dumb Angel isn't a vampire, but the review usually ends "so all in all, if you're a fan of *Angel*, you should check it out." Although I just watched a review of *Angel: After the Fall* #14 wherein she says "if things don't change soon, I'm gonna stop reading this." To which I say, "give it three more issues."

### QUESTION 4

*Brian, with After the Fall you've managed to develop each major character further. Is there one character whose story you've enjoyed developing most? And Chris, do you have a favorite character in the story?*

—Ethan Connolly

I think it would be a toss-up between Connor and Gunn. Connor because we got to take him in a fun new direction, and Gunn because of the really dark places we got to go with him. I love Gunn on the TV show, and to drag him through all of this, it was exciting.

#### QUESTION 5

(The obverse of one of Enisy's questions)

*Is there any idea of yours (or Joss') that you regret including in the story so far, and if so, can you tell us what it was?*

—DeborahMM

I can't think of any. But I do wish we could have given Nina more to do. Just not enough time. I blew it there.

#### QUESTION 6

*What do you think it is about Angel (the character and the show) that continues to inspire such devotion and love from the fans, and makes him such an enduring character?*

—Brendan Collins

Oh that's an easy one. Angel gets beat up, Angel loses, Angel gets everything taken away from him, but he keeps on fighting. And he'll do what he thinks is the right thing even if it means he has to suffer for it. Plus he kicks ass and is funny and charming.

Great, now it sounds like I want to date Angel. A new "ship" for people to write slash fiction about! Don't you dare.

#### QUESTION 7

*How were you able to decide which characters would stay in or jump to (or jump back to, as is the case with Connor) the foreground of the story and which characters were going to have to take a back seat?*

—Jack Gallegos

I think it's a question of using whoever fit the story best. Absolutely Lorne is really important to Angel's world (and I'm obviously a fan, as readers of *Spike: Shadow Puppets* can attest) but his part of *After the Fall* could be told in a shorter amount of time. Meanwhile, Connor, who didn't get as much screen-time as Lorne on the TV show, fit into the themes and the story much much easier. In fact, more than I thought he would. It gets to a point where the characters kind of take over and you just hold on and transcribe.

#### QUESTION 8

(Dominic and Jean-Vic had similar questions, so let's put 'em together and answer both in one fell swoop! Take that, two birds, you didn't see that stone coming, did you?)

*How do you manage fan expectation? The fight in the alley was such a stirring moment that for a long time seemed like the last testament to Angel and Co. Now that*

*you have been given the reigns to the next chapter in Angel's saga, how did you go about the plotting processes knowing how loyal and demanding Angel fans are?*

*The Angel Universe is full of fan battles for their favorite character. Namely Angel and Spike, and Illyria and Fred. Were you ever afraid that you might alienate a certain fan base by writing characters a certain way?*

I love reading fan reaction to the book, but if I were to think about fan expectation while writing it, I'd be too crippled with fear. You can't please everybody. For instance, when the series was announced, I got a ton of emails saying "oh man, Spike better be a lead" but an equal amount of emails stated "please don't have Spike in it." Still others said "I know a thousand billion readers that won't read the book if Cordelia isn't in it" but an equal amount (yes, a thousand billion other people) said that they wanted her to rest in peace. So I just had to write the best story I could, and not worry about expectations.

#### QUESTION 9

Now, I and others are very happy with your work Brian (and of course the artists' and Chris' as well) and are ready to accept After the Fall as canon, not mainly because of Joss' input, but because it's a great story. But just because I'm such a geek, I'm asking you to tell us how much Joss is involved, and how much control you have. I would also love to know how much influence Chris and the artists have.*

Joss sat me down and told me all his ideas. The gang being trapped in hell, Gunn's situation, Wesley's condition, even the ultimate resolution of the series, he had a lot. I then told him mine, he sent me notes with more ideas, I wrote more, the back-and-forth went on for a while, and then I wrote up an extensive outline for the series based on everything we had talked about.

He was great about answering questions, from important ones ("Wesley's situation, is he walking around opening doors like Lilah or is he walking through doors like Spike in season 5?") to really dumb ones ("What if Angel was a human?").

Here is an exchange from our emails, for your reading pleasure:

*ME: So I'm thinking that maybe Gunn would want to cause a reversal of what happened, so everything goes back to how it was. Problem is, whatever he wants to do would either send things back, or make things worse (like, "end of everything that is and will be" worse). In fact, maybe as it gets closer to zero hour on doing whatever Gunn has to do, it's very clear that it WILL wipe everything out, but Gunn is fine with that.*

*I'm babbling, but sometimes, sometimes babbling leads to good ideas. Or sometimes, it leads to a limerick. Either way, entertainment!*

*JOSS: There once was a vampire named Gunn*

*Who nearly destroyed everyone  
When he tried to undo  
All the shit he'd been through  
So his life would be like Season One.*

*Your babbling was good babbling. But the limerick is ass.*

Even his emails are more creative than my scripts. Damn him.

## QUESTION 10

Hope this explained some stuff. I gotta get back to writing, see you all in volume 4!



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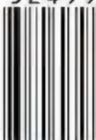
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
